*The NFHS specifies ejectionable actions as: Accruing 2 non-releasable, unsportsmanlike conduct penalties as prescribed in NFHS Boys Lacrosse rule book, page 37, Rule 5-9, Article 1, a, b, & c. These include:*

- A) entering into an argument with an official or attempting to influence the official's decision,*
- B) using threatening, profane or obscene language or gestures, or*
- C) baiting, taunting, or calling undue attention to oneself, or any other act considered unsportsmanlike by the officials.*

*Rule 5-11, page 38, Article 1, a, b, c, or d results in an immediate ejection by the player or coach. These actions include:*

- A) deliberately striking, or attempting to strike anyone or leaving the bench area during an altercation;*
- B) using tobacco or smokeless tobacco;*
- C) Receiving a second nonreleasable unsportsmanlike foul (Rule 5-9, Article 1, d, e, & f are releasable fouls);*
- D) any action deemed by the officials to be flagrant misconduct.*

*When the official issues an ejection penalty, the in-home shall serve a 3- minute non-releasable penalty in place of the ejected player or coach. The player who has been ejected must leave the field but may remain at the bench as long as his behavior does not further interfere with the play of the game. Coaches who are ejected must leave the field and must be out of "sight and sound" of the field.*
